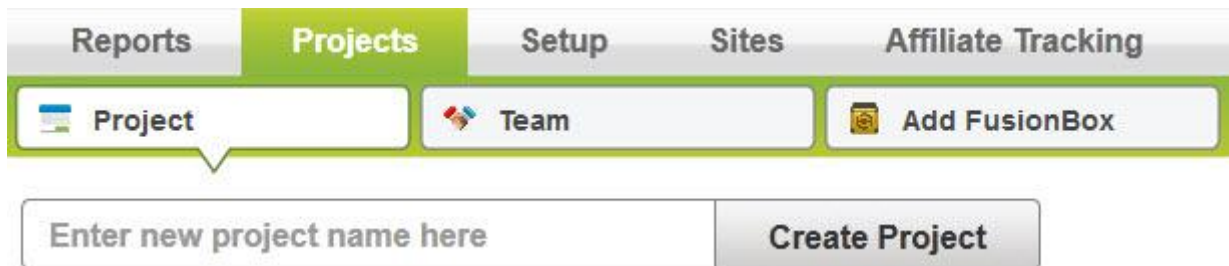


# How to Export A Project

You can give your project to other FusionHQ members so that they can customize it and use it in their own FusionHQ account. Please follow the steps below...

**Step 1:** Go to the "Project" section.



**Step 2:** Click "Export".



**Step 3:** Choose how you want to export your project.

**Step 4: "Update"** means that you have updated the project and you'll use the current key. Choose the previous project you have exported from the drop-down menu. Your recently exported project is top of the list.

**Step 5: "New FusionHQBox Package"** means you need to get a new key for this project.

**Step 6:** If you choose to have a new key, you also need to fill in the **"Package Details"**. You can change the **"Package Name"**. We recommend you change the name of the project each time you export it, to avoid confusion in case you want to update this project later on. Choose a domain. We have free domains which you can use solely for exporting a project. You can also insert a short note for this project for your reference. Then, click **"Export"**.
