

How to Show the Element to Some Members Only

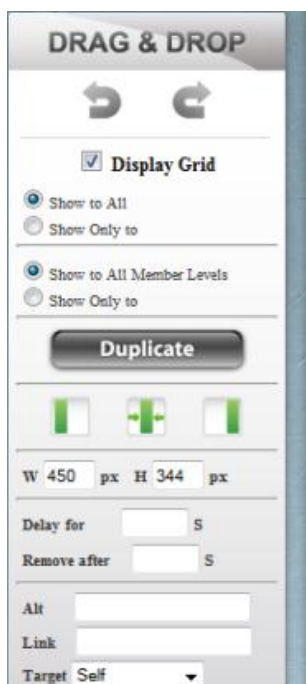
Apart from limit access of the page to some membership levels only, you are able to show the elements on the page to some of them as well. Those who do not grant the membership levels cannot see this element. It is another way to protect your content.

Here's how:

Step 1: Go to the page which you want to use this feature.



Step 2: One click on the element which you want to show to some members only. The selected element will have the green dash border. The Drag & Drop menu will turn to the "Show Only" option.

Step 3: The upper section is to select the product option. If you select "**Show to All**", you allow everyone to see the element. This is the default setting of the element.
