

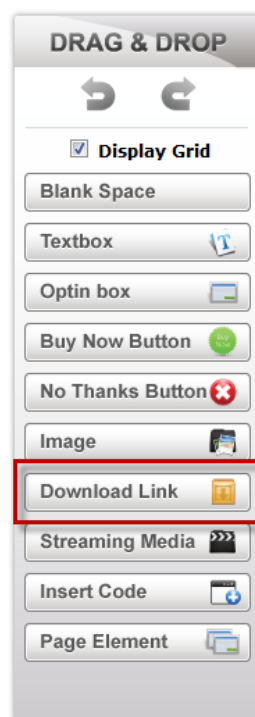
How to Use the "Download Link" Button

Want to add downloads to your thank you pages or membership site pages? No worries but make sure that you have already created your downloadable product in the "**Product**" section. You can use the "**Download Link**" button in either the "**Sales Funnels**" or the "**Content Sites**". Note that if you have several files in one product, so you need to use a different "**Download Link**" button for each product.


Step 1: Go to the page where you would like your clients to download your file from, by clicking on the pencil icon.



Step 2: Drag the "**Download Link**" element from the "**Drag and Drop**" menu onto your page.




Step 3: In the "Type" section, if you choose "My Product", this is the product that you have set up in FusionHQ. Select the product name and file from the dropdown menu.






