

What Is the "Insert Code" Element?

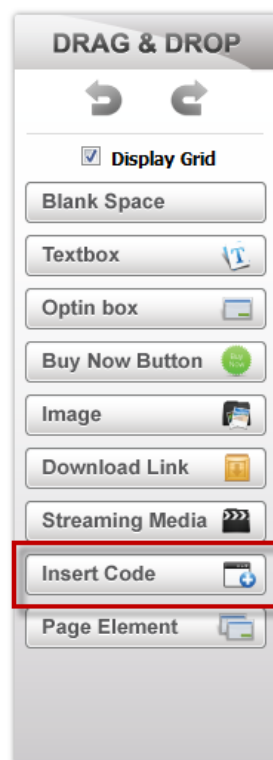
Here in FusionHQ, you can insert some codes into your page if you want to. Our **"Insert Code"** option supports most kinds of code. **However, you need to make sure that the inserted code is correct. Checking the code generated from the 3rd party is beyond our responsibility.**

Here's how to do:

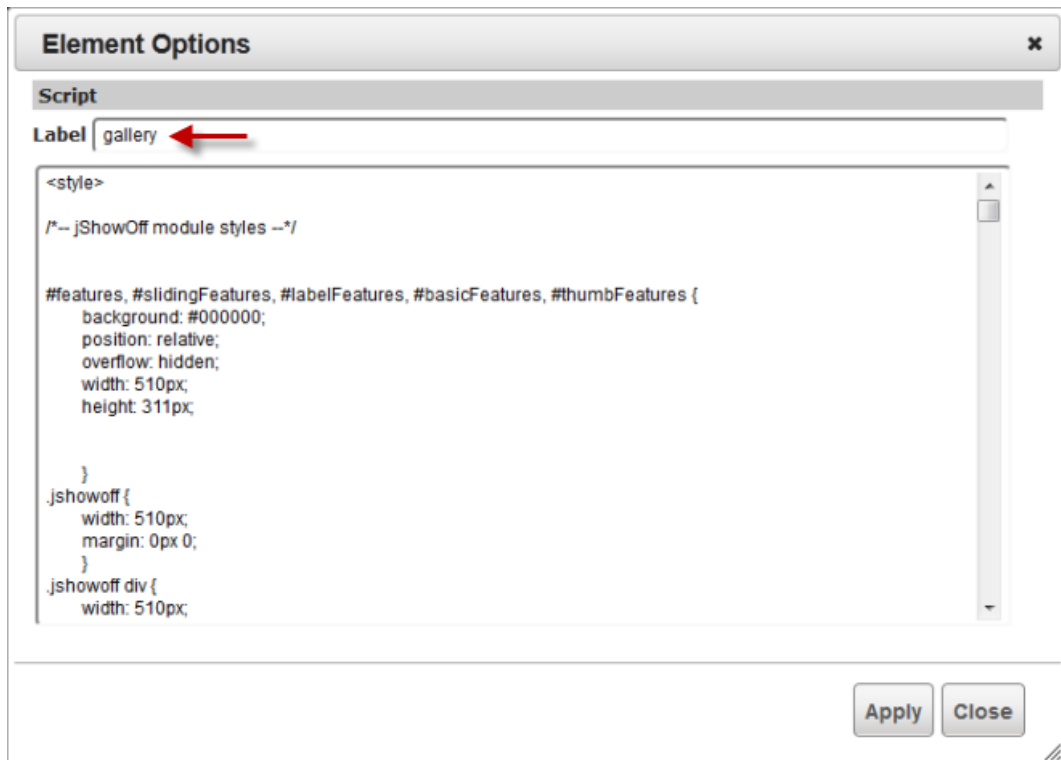
Step 1: Open the page where you want to insert the code by clicking the pencil icon.



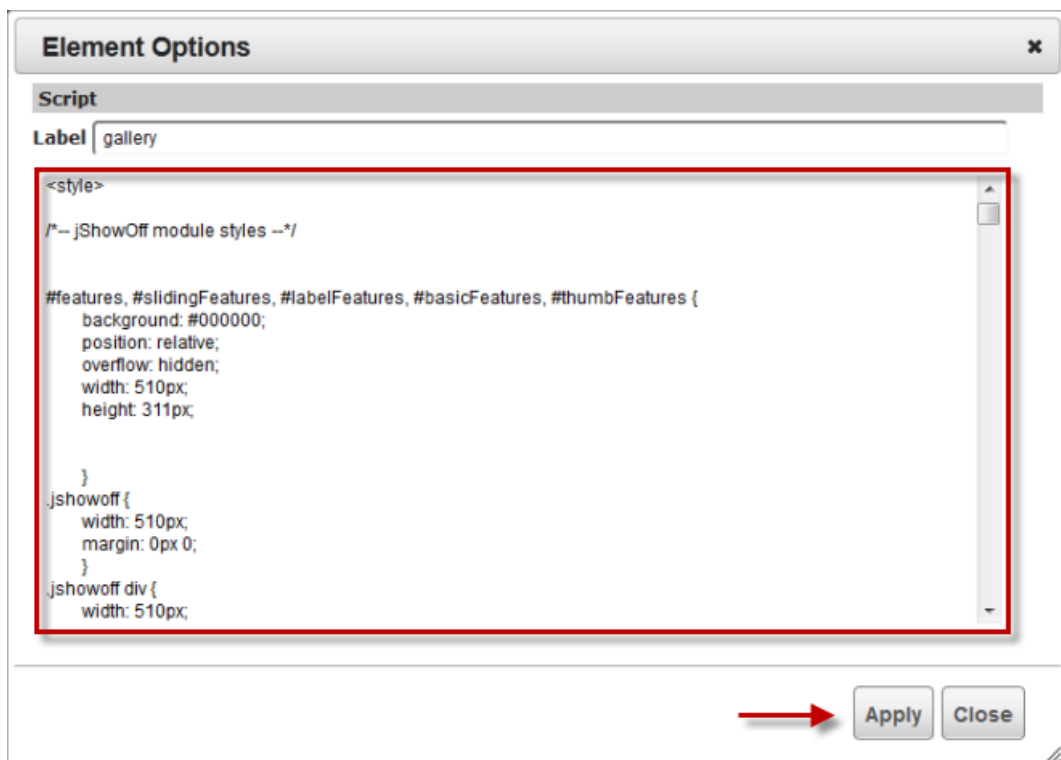
Step 2: From the "Drag and Drop" editor, drag the "Insert Code" element onto your page.



Step 3: You can enter a name in the "Label" textbox. This is only optional and for your own reference only. Just in case you have lots of codes in your page and you don't know which is which, this is really helpful. The name you enter here will show up with the insert code element.



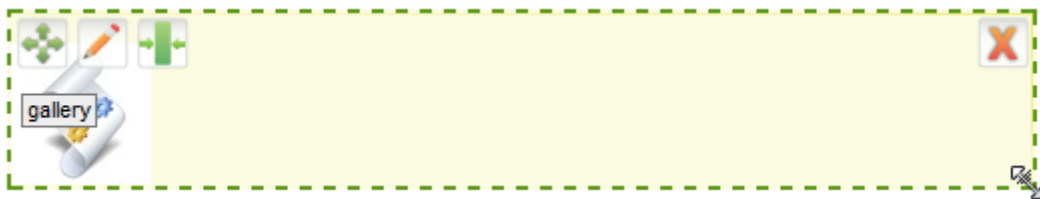
Step 4: Paste/Enter your code. Then apply.



Step 5: This is what your "Insert Code" will look like in your page.



Step 6: You need to resize the element by yourself. One click at the element and you can resize it manually.



Step 7: Click "Save" to save the changes you made in your page.
